(Proverbs 16:31) The silver-haired head is a crown of glory, If it is found in the way of righteousness. (NKJV)

(Proverbs 20:29) The glory of young men is their strength, And the splendor of old men is their gray head. (NKJV)

(Ecclesiastes 11:10) Therefore remove sorrow from your heart, And put away evil from your flesh, For childhood and youth are vanity. (NKJV)

(1 Timothy 4:12) Let no one despise your youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity. (NKJV)

 - Recognize opportunities and abilities
 - Respect and Learn from elders

(1 Timothy 5:1) Do not rebuke an older man, but exhort him as a father, younger men as brothers, (NKJV)
Remember example of Rehoboam.

(Ecclesiastes 11:9) Rejoice, O young man, in your youth, And let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth; Walk in the ways of your heart, And in the sight of your eyes; But know that for all these God will bring you into judgment. (NKJV)

(Ecclesiastes 12:1) Remember now your Creator in the days of your youth, Before the difficult days come, And the years draw near when you say, "I have no pleasure in them": (NKJV)

 - (Proverbs 5:18) Let your fountain be blessed, And rejoice with the wife of your youth. (NKJV)

(Malachi 2:14) ...Because the LORD has been witness Between you and the wife of your youth, With whom you have dealt treacherously; Yet she is your companion And your wife by covenant. (NKJV)

(Psalms 127:3-4) Behold, children are a heritage from the LORD, The fruit of the womb is a reward. Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, So are the children of one's youth. (NKJV)
- 15  **Those With Children**
(Psalms 127:5) Happy is the man who has his quiver full of them; They shall not be ashamed, But shall speak with their enemies in the gate. (NKJV)
- 16  **Those with Grandchildren**
(Proverbs 17:6) Children's children are the crown of old men, And the glory of children is their father. (NKJV)

(2 Timothy 4:6-7) For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. (NKJV)
